WHAT IS TOLERANT?

“**TOLERANT: TransnatiOnal network for Employment integrAtion of womeN vicTims of trafficking**” is a European project aiming to enhance the integration of third country national women victims of trafficking (VoT) for sexual exploitation in the labour market in the destination countries and the EU in general through trainings, and thus promoting their economic empowerment.

WHY IS IT NECESSARY?

Following identification and meeting of the basic needs of VoT (accommodation, residence permit, psychological and social support etc.), employment appears to be the most important factor in the process of integration, enabling women to become financially independent and self-sufficient in the long-term.

TOLERANT NETWORK PLATFORM

Under the TOLERANT project, a transnational informal network platform was developed to support women victims of trafficking. The overall aim of the **TOLERANT Network Platform** is to promote the regular exchange of good practices, experiences and information related to groundwork for the women's VoT integration in employment. The platform is developed for the benefit of a variety of actors and stakeholders from Europe and beyond, who are facing similar challenges with the labor integration of VoT in their countries.

- **career counseling**
- **job mediation and information** on the local labor market
- **support** in recognition of professional qualifications
